NOTE: TEAMS ENTER THROUGH DOOR CLOSEST TO DIVING BOARDS -

SIGNS WILL BE UP WHEN DIVING IS IN PROGRESS

PLEASE RESPECT THE DIVERS BY QUIET ENTRY

ENTRY LIMITS:

Team individual entries - teams may enter up to 4 athletes in each individual event, including diving

Team relay entries - teams may only enter 1 relay per event, please include alternates with your submitted entry

Individual athlete limits - an individual athlete can enter a maximum of four events, only two of which can be individual events

ENTRY DEADLINE IS TUESDAY, JANUARY 23 BY 7 PM

Entries in Team Manager data file preferred, along with pdf report of entries

Don't have Team Manager software? 2 things

1) Please send a typed (or word processed) roster list of your athletes, first & last names and class year by Friday, Jan. 19 at 8 pm

2) Please send your entries in typed or word process list by Tuesday, January 23 at 7 pm

Why the roster list? Entering the roster names and class years ahead of time saves a lot of time when making entries later

POINT SCORING:

The AAA Conference meet scores up to 12 places

Scoring key:

Individual top 6 = 16-13-12-11-10-9

Individual 7-12 = 7-5-4-3-2-1

Relays 1-7 = 32-26-24-22-20-18-14

AWARDS:

Top 3 places in each event get medals (4 medals each for top relay teams)

Awarded after each event - medals given by coach of winning swimmer/relay of that event

Plaque awarded to highest scoring team at end of meet

NOW THE PART THAT IS THE REALITY OF HOLDING CONFERENCE AT WESTMINSTER:

It appears all coaches have done this before, so you've seen the space:

The seating area is VERY small.

We expect 89 athletes to take part in the meet--this does not count coaches, managers or gear.

We do not have a crash area, nor can we put chairs in the foyer

Because of this, we have to limit the number of spectators and others a team may bring.

Again, this is not a yesteryear COVID thing, this is a space thing.

So here is what we do:

EACH TEAM GETS UP TO 5 NON-SWIMMERS IN BLEACHERS-- *including coaches, asst coaches, team managers.*

These are in addition to meet volunteers (see below):

VOLUNTEERS NEEDED: One way to guarantee to see the meet in person!

Timers: (22) We have 3 stop-watch timers at the end of every competition lane to get state cuts if electronic timing fails.

Runners: (2) Runs any manual time to meet director, or anything else needed

Awards: (2) Gets event results from meet director to awards table, organizes medals for handout

Hospitality: (3) Delivers waters, etc to officials, meet director, volunteers during the meet
